7. After 1♦ Openings

Zwerling-Tolliver Mid-Chart Conventions

Unless the opponents overcall in a minor, $2 \diamondsuit$, 2N, $3 \diamondsuit$, $4 \diamondsuit$ and one other 2 level call that varies depending on the auction show both minors. Opener should not get carried away since he is known to have at least one minor.

a. Minor Showing Bids

- 2♦¹⁴ shows a non-distributional game forcing hand. In response, Opener may show a minimum with 2N, 3♣ or 3♦ or bid the step suit to relay Responder's shape (4-4 first, then show 5 card suit). Instead of the relay, Opener may bid 2♠ or 3♥ to show an SSC or RKC with 4m.
- 2N an invitational or stronger distributional hand, over which all our mechanisms available over an opening 2N apply.
- 3♣ purely competitive
- 4♣ distributional preempt
