The Oregon state flag, adopted in 1925, is navy blue with gold (the state colors) lettering and symbols. The "STATE OF OREGON" is written above a shield surrounded by 33 stars. Below the shield is written "1859", when Oregon was admitted to the union as the 33rd state. Oregon is the only state whose flag has a different pattern on the reverse side, a beaver.

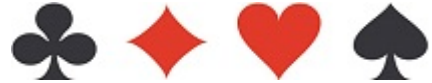
Seaside features several attractions and landmarks related to the famous explorers, Lewis and Clark, who visited the area over 200 years ago. The statue at the center of Seaside's turnaround commemorates their historic journey. The Salt Works, a National Historic Site, is located on Lewis and Clark Way between Beach Drive and the Prom (about 11 blocks south), and marks the believed location of the explorers' salt-making camp. Hike the Tillamook Head trail to retrace the route the explorers took to find a beached whale. For more about the Corps of Discovery expedition, visit the Seaside Museum (570 Necanicum Drive 4 blocks north of the Convention Center; it is open Mon-Sat, 10 am-4 pm, adults \$3, seniors \$2, young children free).

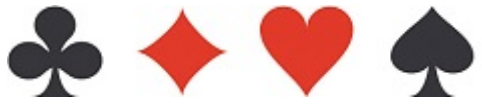

What do you know about your ACBL player number?

(Information from *The Official Encyclopedia of Bridge*)

Since July 1961 the American Contract Bridge League has been assigning each member a 7-digit player number. The last digit in each number is a self-checking device by which the computer knows when to throw out incorrect numbers. The method by which the checking digit is computed is interesting. Multiply the first 6 digits by 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2 respectively, then add these products. Then divide the total of the sum of the products by 11 and note the remainder. Subtract the remainder from the divisor, 11, and the resulting difference should equal the check digit. If it does not, or if the net result of this work is a remainder of 1, then the number is not used. When a player achieves Life Master status, this is indicated by a change in their player number by the substitution of a letter for the first digit, alphabetically, from J for 1 to R for 9.
