It is open from 9 a.m.; adults $\$ 8$, seniors $\$ 6.75$, kids 6-13 $\$ 4$, young children free).

## Reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership. Other types of convention cards, such as the WBF card or homemade cards that do not sufficiently resemble the ACBL convention card are not acceptable substitutes. If a director finds that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. Also, the partnership will receive a $1 / 6$ board matchpoint penalty for each board played, beginning with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. The restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director.

## B) NE <br> A SIMPLIFIED GUIDE FOR REMEMBERING BOARD VULNERABILITY

Think in sets of four boards, e.g., 1-4,5-8,9-12, and 13-16. The vulnerability for the first set, $1-4$, starts $O$ (noone vulnerable), then $N$ ( $\mathrm{N}-\mathrm{S}$ vulnerable), then E ( $\mathrm{E}-\mathrm{W}$ vulnerable), and finally B (both vulnerable). For the second set of four, move the first $O$ to the end of the set (5-8: NEBO). For the third set, move the first N-S to the end (9-12: EBON). For the fourth set, move the first E-W to the end (13-16: BONE). Repeat the system for sets 17-20 (like 1-4), 21-24 (like 5-8), and 25-28 (like 9-12). Then all you have to
 think of is a) which set of 4 ? and b) which cycle? EASY, HUH?
