

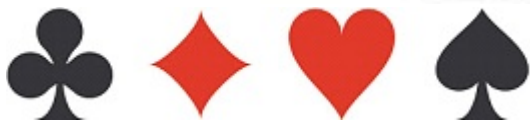

### COSTS



The cost of traveling over the Oregon Trail varied widely. About 60-80 percent of the travelers were farmers, so they already owned a wagon, livestock team, and many of the needed supplies, lowering the cost to about \$50 per person for food and other items. Families planned far ahead and made many of the extra clothes and required items, but those buying most of their supplies might spend \$150-200 each. Women seldom traveled alone. Pioneers with money could buy livestock in the midwest and drive it to California or Oregon for profit. It was cheapest to hire on to help drive the wagons or herds, reducing costs or even making a small profit. As the trail matured, additional costs for ferries and toll roads may have been about \$30 per wagon. E.g., a popular Oregon Trail branch

leading to the Willamette Valley was the Barlow Road, which was carved through the forest around Mount Hood from The Dalles in 1846 as a toll road costing \$5 per wagon and 10 cents per head of livestock. It was rough and steep with poor grass but still cheaper and safer than floating goods, wagons, and family down the dangerous Columbia River.

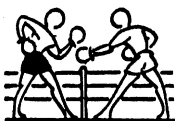

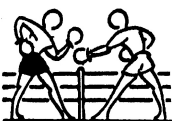

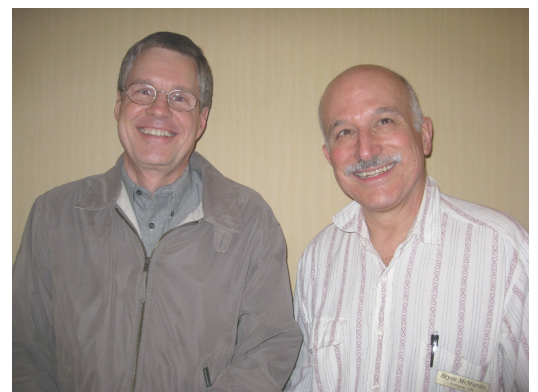
