



ACBL District 20 Grand National Teams 2023 Competition

Conditions of Contest: ACBL District 20

Club and Unit Stage:

Clubs and Units may run GNT club-qualifying games (GNTQ's) for all their sanctioned in-person sessions (online GNTQ's are excluded), from September 1, 2022, through February 28, 2023. Sessions must be team games that incur an ACBL charge of \$2.25 per table. These games pay extra masterpoints with 1/2 red points and are independent of the Finals competition outlined below.

District Finals:

The District GNT Finals will consist of a Swiss or Round-Robin qualifying stage followed by a knockout stage via BBO. Note: club-qualification is not required to play in the D20 Finals competition.
