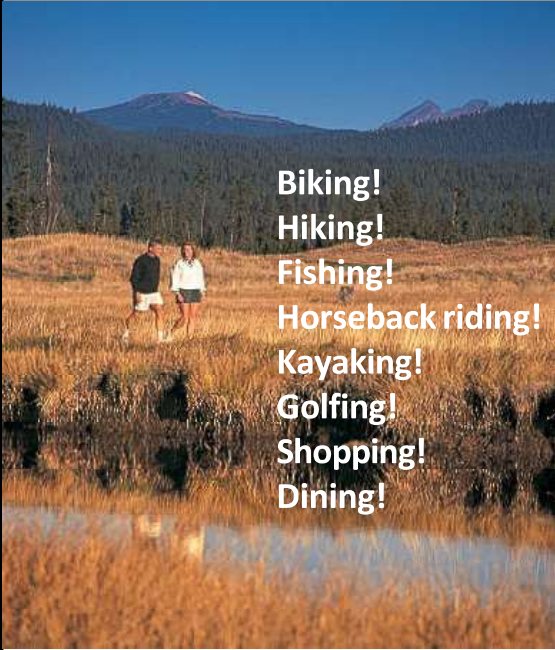
SCHEDULE NOTES

Explore Bend, a cosmopolitan little mountain town of 80,000, with 14 world class craft breweries (and counting) plus 200 restaurants and shops.



Go white water rafting on the Deschutes River, which originates high in the Cascade mountains from Little Lava Lake, and finally flows into the Columbia.



Enjoy a picnic in Drake Park and at Mirror Pond in the heart of Bend. The park is home to nesting Great horned owls.

Visit Tumalo Falls - 97 feet tall and an impressive feature of the Deschutes National Forest. Another landmark is Newberry Crater, a caldera about the size of Rhode Island. Newberry is both seismically and geothermally active. Visitors see numerous cinder cones and vents (over 400 throughout the area), miles of basalt flows, and rhyolite flows of obsidian.
